

Personalized Blended Learning
Pilot/Implementation Plan USD 400

Year One: (Pilot) 2014-2015 School year

- Middle School (7-8) – Any teacher may apply to pilot individual units throughout the 2014-2015 school year.
 - Surveys: The teacher and students in the blended learning environment will be surveyed once per nine weeks. The parents of those students will be surveyed once per semester. Teacher reflection.
 - Data: Classroom assessments. Individually determined by the teacher and administration.
- High School-Have two core teachers pilot blended learning throughout the 2014-2015 school year.
 - Surveys: The teachers and students in the blended learning environment will be surveyed once per nine weeks. The parents of those students will be surveyed once per semester. Teacher reflection.
 - Data: Classroom assessments. Individually determined by the teacher and administration.

(The pilot teachers for year one will be chosen through an application process. Collaboration time will be created for those selected teachers.)

If approved by the school board to proceed.

Year Two: 2015-2016 School year

- Middle School (7-8) – No less than two core teachers have blended learning classrooms.
- High School – No less than four core teachers have blended learning classrooms.
 - Surveys: The teachers and students in the blended learning environment will be surveyed once per semester. The parents of those students will be surveyed once per year.
 - Data: Classroom assessments. Individually determined by the teacher and administration.

(The pilot teachers will continue to have a blended learning classroom, and the additional teachers will be chosen from an application process. The pilot teachers will be considered the mentors for the newly selected teachers. Collaboration time will be created for those teachers.)

Year Three: 2016-2017 School year

- Middle School (7-8) – Any teacher
- High School – Any teacher
 - Data: Classroom assessments. Individually determined by the teacher and administration.

Year Four: 2017-2018 School year

Full implementation of blended learning in grades 7-12

***At anytime during the given years, if a teacher who is not in a blended learning classroom, wishes to try blended learning may do so by submitting a proposal to their building administrator. A teacher may only propose one unit at a time. At the conclusion of the approved unit, the teacher will submit teacher reflection and data (student reflection and academic progress) to the committee.
